

BIRTLEY ROF ANGLING CLUB RULES AND REGULATIONS

1) TITLE: The Club shall be called the ROF Angling Club.

2) CONDITIONS OF MEMBERSHIP

1) Members of the ROF Angling Club on payment of a joining fee and annual subscription are given full voting rights.

2) The AGM shall be held the last Tuesday in January each year at which shall be presented the annual reports, the statement of accounts and at which shall be appointed a Chairman, Secretary, Treasurer and a Committee.

3) A Special General Meeting will be called when 20% of the membership, giving full reasons in writing to the Secretary, signifying such.

4) The Committee may call for a General Meeting at any time.

5) Not less than 14 days' notice, and not more than 28 days, for any General Meeting must be given to Members.

6) A quorum to consist of 20% of the membership at any Annual General Meeting.

7) The Committee has the power to appoint any Member to an official position until the Annual General Meeting is called.

8) Rules and Regulations can only be changed at an Annual General Meeting.

9) The annual subscriptions, payable to the Club, shall be determined at the Annual General Meeting.

10) Subscriptions shall be paid before the 28th February each year, or immediately on joining if after this date.

11) Members failing to comply with any Club rules will be dealt with by the Committee. The Committee has the power to terminate membership to the Club.

12) The financial year shall commence on the 1st of January and end on the 31st of December.

RIGHTS AND PRIVILEGES

1) The right, privileges and liabilities of each Member and visitor shall be personal and shall not in any circumstance be transferable or transmissible.

2) A member or visitor abusing the privileges or accessories of the Club shall render him/herself liable to expulsion and/or prosecution.

3) The ROF Angling Club shall not be held responsible for, or involved in, any personal accident, legal or financial liability of any Club Member or visitor, whether or not such liability arises from his/her connection with the Club.

4) Any Member having cause for complaint must put the complaints in writing to the Secretary.
